#### **Folsom Lake Estates Homeowners Association Board Meeting**

May 15, 2025, 6:00pm FLE Community Park, Granite Bay

#### IN ATTENDANCE

**Board Members**: Linda Bollinger, Brian Mulrooney, Ryan Overman, and Chris Vadnais

**OPEN FORUM/HOMEOWNER COMMENTS:** : Attending residents expressed concern about neighbors' cars that are being parked on a regular basis, around-the-clock, in the community park's parking lot. The Board will give this issue further consideration. Residents inquired about a FLE house that backs to Barton Road where a fence has been installed that extends beyond their neighbors'. The Board shared that they were aware of the situation, but could not discuss details, due to privacy issues.

**REVIEW OF APPROVED APRIL 2025 GENERAL MEETING MINUTES:** Treasurer Mulrooney discussed some light trimming to the redwoods at the MacDuff entrance to improve visibility. Folsom Landscaping will complete the work in the coming weeks. He will also speak with Folsom Landscape Maintenance about clearing the Barton Road lot.

**TREASURER'S REPORT:** The current total balance of all accounts stands at \$225,616. Operating account balance is \$87,231, which is on track to meet FLEHA's 2025 budget requirements. Reserve account balance is \$138,384, distributed between a savings account and two 3-month CDs that mature in the summer. The balance provides a strong rating (83%) per the Browning Reserve Group's latest survey regarding FLEHA's ability to repair/replace major components in future years.

#### COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Architectural Review: : A resident expressed concern about a new construction home where a retaining wall was built into or right up to the setback. The Board reiterated that permanent structures are not allowed in setbacks and the HOA has the right to request that the wall be moved if it is inside the setback. VP Bollinger will contact the resident who raised the concern to determine if the Board needs to take action.

Park: It has been five years since the trees in the park were last assessed and trimmed by an arborist, at which time it was agreed to schedule a 5-year check-up. Admin has met with two arborists and awaits their proposals. The Board selected the "slow down" sign templates that will be posted around the park, which resident Walt Worthge will install.

High-Speed Internet, Per Astound: All vaults have been set for the entire neighborhood. PG&E has requested that Astound move their micro trench closer to the center of the road, further from their utilities. This has delayed the trenching since it requires that Astound resubmit permits to the county. They hope for approvals in a week. Astound has a list of residents that will be taking service and need service conduit/drops to the side of their homes. #### **OLD BUSINESS**

**Social Events:** National Night Out will feature a water slide and possibly another water play structure (courtesy of VP Bollinger) as well as ice cream/Italian ice carts. For Concert in the Park Bollinger is investigating a carnival/fall festival concept.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:50pm, 4/0/0.

The Board held an Executive Session immediately after the general meeting.

## Fire Wise Event Recap Partnering for a Safer Community



On June 12 our local fire station hosted its first **Fire Wise event** in collaboration with **Folsom Lake Estates**, offering vital fire preparedness tips for homeowners. About a dozen neighbors attended, enjoying pizza, drinks, and expert guidance on making homes more resilient to wildfire.

Key takeaways from the presentation include recommendations on implementing these **Fire Safety Zones** on our properties:

#### Zone Zero (0-5 feet from the home)

- •Keep flammable mulch, plants, pine needles, and debris 5+ feet from structures and out of gutters, roofs, and skylights.
- •Remove flammable items from garages, attics, crawl spaces, and carports, especially during high-temperatures.

# Fire Wise Event Recap Partnering for a Safer Community

• Use non-combustible materials for siding as well as for fencing that touches a structure.

#### Zones 1 & 2 (5-60 feet)

- Trim grasses to under 4" and manage fuel ladders.
- Keep plants watered and dispose of flammable debris.
- Maintain a 5-foot no-flammable-debris buffer around outbuildings and sheds.

   FLEHA: Folsom Lake Estates Homeowners Association includes all 225 Unit 2 homeowners plus voluntary Unit 1 members (currently about half of the 67 Unit 1 homeowners are HOA members). See neighborhood map in newslette for unit boundaries.

   Membership/Dues: Mandatory Unit 2 annual FLEHA membership dues are \$350, as of 2025. Unit 1 voluntary annual membership dues are \$140. Dues due by Feb 1; a 10% late fee applies. A courtesy billing reminder is sent on 18.

   Membership Benefits: Unit 2 members receive: one sports court key; option reserve picnic grove and soccer field; copy of/inclusion in directory; FLEHA newsletter and free ad; email notifications; right to vote for and be a Board member. Unit 1 members receive the same benefits, but are not bound by U 2 CC&Rs, and therefore not allowed to vote for or be Board members.

   Board of Directors: Consists of five elected Unit 2 FLEHA members President, VP, Treasurer, Secretary, and Member-at-Large each serving a tyear term. Board members help ensure that our Bylaws are upheld, that our association is in compliance with Davis-Stirling HOA regulations, and that community concerns are addressed. Additionally, they maintain the park and the three neighborhood entrances, perform an architectural review process, and coordinate several annual social gatherings, including our December 24 luminary lighting.

   Board Elections: Held annually in January (ballots are mailed on January 1 along with dues notification). Only Unit 2 members are eligible to vote and r Candidates who submit a "Notice of Desire to be a Candidate" form (availab in November) by close of nominations on December 12 will be added to the ballot. Note: "if after the close of nominations, the number of qualified pec nominated for election to the Board of Directors is equal to or less than the number of directors to be elected, then those nominees who are qualified to be elected to the Board are deemed elected." along with dues notification). Only Unit 2 members are eligible to vote and run. Candidates who submit a "Notice of Desire to be a Candidate" form (available ballot. 

- **December 24 Luminaries**: FLE's signature neighborhood event began in 1972. Volunteers organize the purchasing and distribution of candles, bags, and sand. Orders are typically due in Sep-Oct and delivered in November, and then lit at sundown on December 24.
